


Integrity Report Q2 2024

IBIA reported a total of **90 sports betting alerts** to the relevant authorities concerning **8 sports** during Q2 2024*

The International Betting Integrity Association (IBIA) represents many of the largest regulated betting operators in the world. IBIA's principal goal is to protect its members, consumers and partners, such as sports bodies, from fraud caused by the unfair manipulation of sporting events and associated betting. The association combats this fraud with evidence-based intelligence, principally obtained from its global monitoring and alert system.






Q2 2024 ABC Trends

Analysis: eSports

48 eSports alerts

reported in Q2 2024



A single eSports case relates to suspicious betting activity on 68 eSoccer matches played in Q1 & Q2 2024. This has caused a significant increase in the overall number of eSports alerts in 2024, with 91 eSports accounting for 50% of all alerts in Q1 & Q2 2024.



IBIA members operating in Brazil represent more than 60% of the gambling market.

Over the last five years IBIA has reported 45 cases of suspicious betting activities on Brazilian sporting events.

Those cases were identified by IBIA's unique global monitoring and reporting network which is based on customer transaction account data and is only available to IBIA and its members.

Brazil's legislation requires that its licensed operators are part of an independent betting integrity monitoring body, such as IBIA.





























































